

Read Acts 2:41-47

⁴¹ Then those people who accepted what Peter said were baptized. About 3,000 people were added to the number of believers that day. ⁴² They spent their time learning the apostles' teaching. And they continued to share, to break bread, ^[a] and to pray together.

The Believers Share

⁴³ The apostles were doing many miracles and signs. And everyone felt great respect for God. ⁴⁴ All the believers stayed together. They shared everything. ⁴⁵ They sold their land and the things they owned. Then they divided the money and gave it to those people who needed it. ⁴⁶ The believers met together in the Temple every day. They all had the same purpose. They broke bread in their homes, happy to share their food with joyful hearts. ⁴⁷ They praised God, and all the people liked them. More and more people were being saved every day; the Lord was adding those people to the group of believers.
