Activity 1

Make a poster about what you can remember from our light topic. See if you can answer these questions on your poster:


- What is a light source? Remember to give examples.

Task 1:

Task 2:

Shine a torchlight on the following objects and make a note of what happens:

- A glass of water - transparent object
- A mug or cup - opaque object
- A shiny spoon - reflective object

Move the torch around the objects to see how the light behaves. Write down your findings.
