<p>Retrieve</p> 	<p>R3 – On what date did Robert Falcon Scott finally reach the South Pole? 17th January 1912</p>
<p>Interpret</p> 	<p>I – How do you think Scott felt when he got to the South Pole? Explain your reasoning referring to the text. These are possible answers. (You may have a different answer, but make sure you have used evidence from the text to justify your answer.)</p> <p>Disappointed – they put in all that effort but were beaten.</p> <p>Proud – they actually made it to the South Pole despite all the difficulties</p> <p>Frustrated – they were beaten there and then had a really difficult journey to get back</p>
